It depicts the experiences of a mother and her four children, their interaction, personalities, and search for a secure and stable existence. It recounts travel at home and abroad and desire to reach beyond a parochial existence. The lessons drawn from this account include learning to respect our elders and their wisdom and counsel, to seek personal autonomy in the face of peer and family pressures, and to turn setbacks and disappointments into achievements and success.
